- Minority and majority views have equal weight which helps facilitate consensus



Better Reykjavík



- Opened a week before the 2010 elections in Reykjavik, independent of political parties
- Over 40% of voters participated, 8% added content and over 1000 ideas were created
- The Best Party needed a policy and shouted out:
 'Come to Better Reykjavik to tell us what to do'

From jokes to mayor



- The Best party (Jón Gnarr) was topping in polls when they saw Better Reykjavik
- Saw a solution for their lack of policy and used supporters to help create platform
- Many ideas became part of coalition agreement



Rahvakogu - Estonian reforms

- After political scandals in Estonia in 2012 grassroots
 NGOs and President of Estonia lead a law reform project
- In 2014 over 50.000 people took part and sent in over 2000 proposals with Your Priorities
- 7 of 15 top ideas are now in Estonian law





Pirate Party united



- Icelandic Pirate Party called out with Your Priorities for its grassroots priorities
- It's members are very diverse with many very different views
- The top ideas were then approved with a large majority at its annual meeting

New constitution



Following the financial collapse in 2008 began a major debate about the need to create a new social contract to reflect the will of the people had made a new constitution. The process began with efforts enable the most with. Parliament called for the will of the people, followed by a referendum and got a decisive conclusion then was ignored. The modern constitution brings, among other things, power to the people was buried in authority. Time has come to respect the will of the people.











Strengthening democracy at every level.



Public participation in decisions taken by the state, municipalities and coowned (nk matrices) is low. Availability and access are generally bad, it is difficult to find information on how the acquisition takes place on the sandbank and thereby affect the progress. This can change the Pirate Party and had the support of núliggjandi data in this work. The proposal is that we work a frame, a kind of democracy glasses, which can be applied anywhere in the administration to assess the level of democracy and to provide redress

Better Neighbourhoods process


- 1. Citizens submit their ideas
- 2. City of Reykjavik evaluates their cost
- 3. Citizens vote on the ideas
- 4. City of Reykjavik executes them
- 5. Citizens use the results




What is it and how does it work?

- The mission is to improve the city of Reykjavik according to the wishes of its citizens
- Each voter has the same budget amount as the total and chooses which projects she wants to vote for
- Our e-voting software teaches citizens the realities of budgeting








In general

- 420 ideas have been approved by citizens in Better neighborhoods from 2012 - 2015
- The vote is electronic, binding and secure
- All neighborhoods of Reykjavik have been improved visibly through Better Neighborhoods



Change the current NHS England proposals to automatically collect data from GP patient records unless patients 'opt out'.

This is called automatically 'opted in'. The care data project will then harvest GP data on a monthly basis and the data could be made available to private companies.

Irrespective of opt-out vs opt-in, consent must be informed

Much clearer explanation of the benefits, and risks of the sharing of their data. Much more detail on when and how and why it will be shared, and the right to opt out again.

We should give consent to our data being collected

A basic principle of medical ethics is 'informed consent'. This means patients should always be

Allow individual citizens online access to their own data

No data should be collected, unless the patient also has online access to all their own data. It seems totally unethical that date is collected about me and shared with 3rd parties, but I am not given access. Not only does this reduce safety for the patient, it also facilitates toe collection of data which may be inaccurate (the patient would have the motivation to ensure that their data was checked and considered accurate)
